#### 3. Rationale

The year 2015 sees the imminent commencement of ASEAN community which consists of 10 countries in Southeast Asian Region. The co-operation comprises three pillars namely: ASEAN Economic Community, ASEAN Socio – Cultural Community, and ASEAN Political – Security Community.

Whilst the first co-operative pillar begins in 2015, the other two pillars will subsequently follow.

As a responsive undertaking towards ASEAN’s Socio-Cultural co-operative policy, ICOMOS THAI with the co-operation of the Architectural Heritage Management and Tourism Programme, Faculty of Architecture, Silpakorn University will co-host an International Conference on Conservation of the Built Environment. In addition, it also places an emphasis on the importance of cultural resource management in assisting social and economic developments.
